Most recent role

Whilst working at NHS Foundation Trust, Pathway Navigator - Cancer Service, her key responsibilities included being responsible for the department data management of cancer patients including preparation, coordination, ensuring that diagnosed cancer patients have a treatment care plan, ensuring data completeness and data quality for National Reporting to NHS England including carrying out a Route Cause Analysis (RCA) for complex cancer cases. During this role she gained experience liaising with Trusts at a National level to ensure a smooth transition of patient care for vulnerable cancer patients, gathering departmental requirements to develop a strategic plan and presented at C-Suite level and analysing in house hospital systems to eliminate bottle necks and increase efficiencies and cost savings across the department.

Key experience

- Ensuring all patients that are newly diagnosed are entered onto the PAS and data completeness is entered in a timely manner, making sure all diagnoses and investigations are entered and supporting the Cancer Management team and the MDT Lead Clinician in developing strategies to ensure smooth running of the MDT meetings
- Responsible for the department data management of cancer patients including preparation, coordination, ensuring that diagnosed cancer patients have a treatment care plan
- Proactively monitored Cancer patient pathways to ensure that all elements of the patient's care are arranged as appropriate. Including making any necessary arrangements for patients e.g. booking follow up appointments or diagnostics.
- Effectively tracked cancer patients through their clinical pathway to ensure that they are seen and treated within nationally set cancer target waiting times. This included being proactive in following up on decisions made by multi-disciplinary teams e.g. chasing for diagnostics and RTT letters
